The North American Araucanian Royalist Society [NAARS] is dedicated to preserving the memory of the Kingdom of Araucania and Patagonia.

The NAARS affirms three fundamental principles:

1. The Mapuche have a fundamental right of self-determination;
2. The creation of the Kingdom of Araucania and Patagonia in 1860 was a legitimate exercise of the Mapuche right to self-determination; and,
3. The eight legitimate occupants of the throne of the Kingdom of Araucania and Patagonia have been Orelie-Antoine de Tounens (1825-1878) as Orelie-Antoine I, Achille Laviarde (1841-1902) as Achille I, Antoine-Hippolyte Cros (1833-1903) as Antoine II, Laura-Therese Cros (1856-1916) as Laura-Therese I, Jacques Antoine Bernard (1880-1952) as Antoine III, Philippe Boiry (1927-2014) as Philippe I, Jean-Michel Parasiliti di Para (1942-2017) as Antoine IV, and Frédéric Luz (b. 1964) as Frédéric I.

Membership in the NAARS is restricted to people who freely affirm these principles. Members receive 1) invitations to all NAARS events, 2) access to the NAARS library and archives, and 3) four issues of *The Steel Crown* per dues payment.
